glacier bay national park

From snowcapped mountaintops to deep fjords and freshwater streams, the magnificence of nature is abundant. This UNESCO-listed national treasure hosts eight of the world's most spectacular tidewater glaciers. Humpback whales, sea otters, porpoises and harbor seals enjoy the waters, while black bears and mountain goats wander through the pristine parkland, which you can learn about through the knowledgeable Park Rangers who join you on board.



tracy arm fjord

Tracy Arm Fjord's scenery stuns with its exquisite, wild beauty. Traverse down the narrow waterway past a deep forest. Sparkling waterfalls cascade from high above, while massive glaciers create the perfect backdrop for your picturesque view. This famed fjord is a glittering gem near Juneau, protected within the Tongass National Forest. The enormous Twin Sawyer Glaciers sit at the end of the fjord.



hubbard glacier

A colossal mass of snow and ice, 76 miles long and 1,200 feet deep. Its phenomenal, clear blue hues shimmer in the sunlight. North America's largest tidewater glacier is defined by its awe-inspiring beauty — one of the most stunning wonders in the Great Land. Galloping toward Disenchantment Bay, Hubbard Glacier often calves icebergs the size of 10-story buildings. This immense and awesome sight to behold will leave you feeling small, even on your ship's uppermost deck.



college fjord

College Fjord not only boasts the world's largest collection of tidewater glaciers including the massive Harvard Glacier — but countless opportunities to experience the roar of "white thunder," as enormous pillars of ice break off from the glaciers and crash into the surrounding seas. Discovered in the northwest corner of Prince William Sound during an 1899 research expedition, College Fjord and its glaciers were named after prestigious East Coast schools.
